On Monday, August 31, 2020, Charles Bradley Thomas, 95, of Plumerville, Arkansas went to his Heavenly home with his family standing by his side. Bradley was born on October 28, 1924, in Plumerville, Arkansas to John Anderson Thomas and Bess Hawkins Thomas, the youngest of 7 children. In 1947, Bradley married the love of his life, Roberta "Bobbye" Ramer, and together they raised three children by relying on love, hard work and faith in Christ.

Bradley was a lifelong farmer in Plumerville and spent a 30+ year career with the Arkansas Highway Department as a surveyor. His work took him all over the state of Arkansas and he took pride in all of the roads and bridges that he helped build across this great state. Upon retirement, he focused on cattle farming with his sons. Bradley Thomas was a lifelong member of the First Baptist Church of Plumerville and served his Church faithfully in many roles. He was a former Justice of the Peace and a member of the Conway County Quorum Court as well as a Mason. Among his greatest joys in life were his children, grandchildren and great-grandchildren and he perfectly filled the role of "Pappaw" to all of them.
