Ann Mary Mobley Smith passed away on April 4, 2024, in Mobile, Alabama. She was born in Morrilton, Arkansas, on December 17, 1947, to John Bryce and Katherine Hoelzeman Mobley. Ann graduated from Sacred Heart High School, Arkansas Tech University, and the University of Arkansas at Little Rock.
