



## Annie Lee Allen Culberson

Annie Lee Allen Culberson passed away on August 12, 2010 in Fallon, Nevada where she had resided with her son and daughter-in-law, Loyd and Bonnie Culberson, for the past two years. She was 85 years of age.

Annie Lee was the daughter of Hiram Allen and Deanna Mae Dortch Allen, life-long residents of the Morrilton, Arkansas area. She attended Morrilton area schools and Morrilton High School. She was the wife of Charlie C. Culberson. She married Charlie in Oppelo, Arkansas in 1940, at fifteen years of age, and they reared a family of eight children, six sons and two daughters. They made their lives in the Morrilton, Arkansas areas of Riverview and Willow Bend and in Santa Maria and Tustin, California, residing their later years in Morrilton. She was predeceased by Charlie in April of 2000.

◆ Annie Lee was a mother, homemaker, and helper to Charlie. Charlie was for the most part a farmer, meaning that she worked in the fields with him. When Charlie became an operator of a Service Station in California she was his bookkeeper; when he became a truck farmer in Morrilton, becoming the "Tomato King" of Morrilton during his later years, she was there tending, hawking, and selling tomatoes.

◆ Annie Lee was predeceased by Charlie, one son Ronnie Culberson, and one grandson, Devric Culberson. Of her immediate family she is survived by two sisters and a brother, Gussie Allen Tharp of Bakersfield, CA; Lorene Allen McConnell of Red Oak, TX; and Hairston (Buddy) Allen of Akron, OH. Of her children she is survived by Bill Culberson of Houston, AR; Linda Culberson

Allen of Hawaii; Loyd Culberson of Fallon, NV; Jerry Culberson of Morrilton, AR; Sharon Culberson Adams of Ukiah, CA; Jim Culberson of Orange, CA; and Jeff Culberson of Conway, AR. She is also survived by sixteen Grandchildren and nineteen Great Grandchildren.

A memorial service will be held Saturday, August 28, at 10:00 a.m. at Morrilton First Baptist Church. Interment of her cremains will follow the service at Wolf Cemetery in Riverview.
