Billy Farrell Deaver, age 91, of Plumerville, Arkansas, passed away on Sunday, May 11, 2025. He was born in the Plumerville Bottoms on December 11, 1933, to Burl and Mildred Deaver. He married his High School sweetheart, Mary Sue and they were married 72 years until she passed away in June of 2024.

Throughout his life, Billy Farrell served in many areas of his community, including being the Alderman and then Mayor of Plumerville, Plumerville Fire Department, then Fire Chief, and Justice of the Peace in Conway County. He also served as Mounted Patrol and later Captain, Soil Conservation Board, a Deacon at Portland Missionary Baptist Church, where he had perfect attendance for 58 years. This is just a few of the many things he did to serve his community.

Other than his parents and wife, Bill was preceded in death by his grandson, Doug Deaver; sisters, Letha Jackson Brown and Margaret Tiner; and a special cousin, Son Walker, who spent many hours on the farm with Billy.
