Bro. Billy A. "Sonny" Stone, age 78, of Perryville, Arkansas, went to receive his crown in glory Tuesday, October 8, 2019. He also worked for Perry County Road Department for 17 years retiring as a foreman.

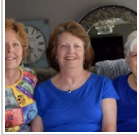
