



Bobby Dale Beavers

October 14, 1949 - August 27, 2024

Bobby Dale Beavers, age 74, of Cleveland, sadly left us on August 27th following a long and courageous battle with cancer. He leaves his loving wife of 54 years, Carlys (Israel) Beavers, daughter Lindsey Hill (Shawn), son Keith Beavers (Annette), daughter Kasey Halbrook (Taylor), brother Burman Beavers (Melba), grandchildren; Lillian Hill, Rawley Halbrook and Rolan Halbrook, numerous loved ones and a cherished church family.

Bobby was born on October 14, 1949, to Elmer and Epsie (Cato) Beavers in a log cabin in Morrilton, Arkansas. In 1970, Bobby married Carlys Israel and moved to Fort Knox, Kentucky, where he was stationed at the Army base prior to serving as a surveyor in the Vietnam War. After returning to the U.S., Bobby and Carlys moved to Alread, Arkansas, and began their family. In 1977, Bobby and Carlys purchased a poultry and dairy farm in Cleveland, Arkansas, where they continued to grow their family and began raising beef cattle.

During these years in Cleveland, Bobby was a poultry and cattle farmer, carpenter, owner of Beavers Truss Company, volunteer firefighter for 35 years, Deacon at New Liberty Church of Christ, and a revered elder in the Cleveland community.

He was preceded in death by his mother, father, brother Burnice Beavers, and sister Juanita Bird.

Bobby enjoyed watching the Razorbacks, checking on his cattle in his jeep, spending time with his grandchildren, and visiting with his neighbors and friends at the Cleveland store. Bobby was a man of few words but graciously

shared his wisdom and led others by his Christian actions. He will be missed by many, and deeply missed by his family.

Services will be 10:00 a.m. Friday, August 30 at the Harris Chapel with Bro. Jay Crow officiating. Burial will be at Cedar Creek Cemetery in Jerusalem, Arkansas. The family will receive friends one hour prior to the service in the chapel. Pallbearers will be Keith Beavers, Shawn Hill, Taylor Halbrook, Jerry Bird, Steven Davenport and Bobby Beavers.
