Bobby Epperson, age 70, of Conway, Arkansas, passed away Friday, April 1, 2022. He was born September 10, 1951, in Morrilton, Arkansas, a son of the late Loyd Mitchell Epperson and Mary Stacks Epperson. He was a police officer for University Central Arkansas in Conway, member of First Baptist Church Morrilton, former Conway County Deputy Sheriff and Chief Investigator, former Conway County Circuit and Chancery Clerk having served four terms, and an avid fisherman.

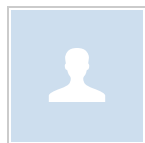
