Carroll Phillip "Brownie" Williams, age 78 of Morrilton passed away July 24, 2010 at his home in Morrilton after a brief illness. He was a loving and gentle father, grandfather, great-grandfather, brother and a true friend to many.

Brownie was a Christian and lifelong Baptist.

He was born September 11, 1931 at Scotland, Arkansas, son of the late Thomas and Rose Williams. He was preceded in death by his precious wife of 42 years, Mary Ashcraft Williams.
