Charles Marlin Stout, age 90, of Conway, passed away on Monday, October 8, 2018. Charles was born on March 23, 1928 to Marlin and Rena Stout of Hattieville. He was retired from Southwestern Bell Telephone Company. He owned and operated Stout Construction and Real Estate from 1974 to 1995, during which time he developed five subdivisions and built over 500 homes. He entered the Maritime Service in 1945.
