



## Charlotte Ruth Miller Hodge

May 21, 1944 - October 12, 2015

Charlotte Ruth Miller Hodge, 71, of Morrilton died Monday, Oct. 12 at home following a lengthy illness. She was born May 21, 1944 in Alton, Ill. to Rev. L C and Alma Miller.

She was a member of Morrilton First Assembly of God where she served as Sunday School teacher, pianist, and choir director. She was also the former owner and managing editor of the Petit Jean Country Headlight and was honored with a 50-year-service award from the Arkansas Press Association in June 2013.

She was a graduate of Morrilton High School and School of Cosmetology. Before joining the Petit Jean Country Headlight she worked at the Russellville Employment Security Division, Oil Mill, Ben Franklin store in Morrilton and Morrilton Democrat.

Her hobbies included collecting angel figurines, reading, playing piano, going out on Wednesdays with the girls (Beadie, Ruth, Jeanetta and others), taking care of shut-ins and talking on the phone.

Survivors include her daughter, Tami Hodge, brother, Larry (Donna) Miller, all of Morrilton and a host of nieces, nephews and other relatives and friends. She was preceded in death by her parents and husband of 50 years Eddy Bruce Hodge.

The family held a private burial Wednesday, Oct. 14, at Elmwood Cemetery.
