Darrall Doughty, age 85, of Houston, Arkansas went to be with his Lord on Thursday, November 5, 2020. Born January 24, 1935 in the Antioch Community, in Perry County, Arkansas he was a son of the late Luther Doughty and the late Ocel Williams Doughty.
