August 30, 1945 - September 26, 2007

David "Bear" Bingham, age 62, of Oppelo, died Wednesday, September 26, 2007, after his seven and a half year battle with cancer. He was born August 30, 1945, in Oppelo, Arkansas, a son of the late James Elmer and Agnes White Bingham. He served in the Army in Vietnam from September 1965 until April 1967. He was a helicopter crew chief. When he returned from the service he worked as a bricklayer with his father and brothers (Bingham Bricklayers) for most of his life. The last five years before he became ill he worked at AmTran in Conway, Arkansas. He was a man of many talents. He mainly enjoyed woodworking that his father passed on to him. David was of the Baptist faith.

He was preceded in death by his father, James Elmer Bingham, and his mother, Agnes Bingham, a sister, Norma Bingham and his brother, Sherman Bingham.

He is survived by his wife, Marilyn (Oaks) Bingham, two sons, Tim Bingham and wife, Rita Bingham of St. Vincent, and Jeremy Bingham and wife, Julie Scroggins-Bingham of Oppelo; three grandchildren that were the love of his life, Haley Marie Bingham, Lindsay Nicole Bingham, and Matthew David Bingham of St. Vincent.
