Ed Ussery, age 65, of Morrilton, passed away, Friday, April 24, 2015. He was born December 30, 1949 in Georgia, a son of Samuel R. Ussery and Joy Easter Bradke Ussery. He served in the Army R.O.T.C and retired as a Special Education Teacher after 36 years of service. During his career he taught at the Center for Exceptional Children, Pine Bluff Training School for Boys, and worked for the Museum of Automobiles on Petit Jean Mountain, as well as being a Special Education Teacher and Bus Driver with the South Conway County School District. He was a member of the Arkansas Teachers Association, Christian Motorcycle Association, Rialto Pickers, and Sacred Heart Catholic Church. He was also a Relay for Life team captain in the local Conway County chapter.

Survivors include his wife, Janie Pinter Ussery of Morrilton; son, Ira Ussery and wife Pam of Perryville; daughter, Angela Long and husband, T.C. of Alma; brother, Dennis Ussery of Enola; sister, Kathryn Ussery Mace and husband Robert of Enola; grandson, Thomas Long of Alma; granddaughters, Lydia Ussery of Perryville; Monica Long of Alma; Maria Long and Cecilia Long both of Alma.
