



Eddy Bruce Hodge

December 30, 1941 - March 19, 2013

Eddy Bruce Hodge, 71, of Morrilton died Tuesday, March 19, at Baptist Medical Center in Little Rock following a lengthy illness. He was born Dec. 30, 1941, to Frank and Hollis Hodge in Dumas, was a member of Morrilton First Assembly of God and general manager and former owner of the Petit Jean Country Headlight. For several years he also raised and sold quarter horses on his ranch that was named Hodgerosa. He received his business degree from State Teachers College, now known as UCA. He wrote several gospel songs and on rare occasions would sing them in church accompanied by his wife Charlotte at the piano.

Survivors include his wife of 50 years, Charlotte (Miller) Hodge; daughter Tamara (Tami) Hodge of Morrilton, brother Johnny (Katie) Hodge of Little Rock, one brother-in-law, Rev. Larry (Donna) Miller of Morrilton, seven nieces; Sheila Plasek and Jamie Caudle of McKinney, Texas, Kim Hodge of Graton, Calif., Michelle Ness and Amy Testone of Greenbrier, Renea Hellmer of Russellville and Cathy Hodge of Conway, three nephews, John Hodge of Fayetteville, Tim Hodge of Pottsville and Les Miller of Morrilton.

He was preceded in death by three brothers, Billy, Bobby and Larry Hodge and one sister, Elizabeth Plasek.

The family held a private burial Wednesday at Elmwood Cemetery. Service
