September 23, 1922 - December 1, 2016

Edward P. "Eddie" Andreas, 94, passed away peacefully with family by his side on December 1, 2016. Eddie was born to Hagop and Maria Gerabedian Andreas September 23, 1922. Eddie graduated from Brownsville High School and studied at Texas A&M. He proudly served his country in the US Army Air Force in World War II as a B-24 Liberator pilot based in Italy, flying 52 missions. He became a pilot with TTA, Texas International and Continental Airlines, retiring with 33 years of service. His passion was flying and a collector of World War II memorabilia, serving as board member of (ALPA) Air Line Pilots Association, and President of the 459th Bomb Group. He served as president of the NHMB in his community and as a member of St. Edward Catholic Church.

He is survived by his loving wife of 62 years: Florence (Babe); his two sons: Ken and Gary Andreas; and many nieces and nephews.

A Memorial Mass will be held 10:00 a.m. Saturday, March 25, 2017 at St. Joseph Catholic Church, 343 Catholic Point Road, Center Ridge, AR 72027, with Father T.J. Hart and Father Joseph Shantiraj officiating. Burial will be at St. Joseph Cemetery. Following burial, all are invited to a dinner reception being held at the Paladino Clubhouse, 74 Morris Mountain Road in Center Ridge.
