



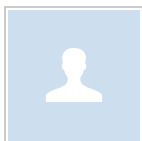
Eula Bell Galloway Baker

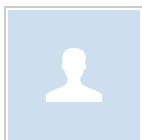

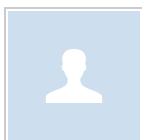
