She was a loving wife and proud mother, grandmother and great-grandmother. She was a strong woman of faith and a longtime member of Calvary Baptist Church in Morrilton.

Fay loved cooking for and spending time with her family. She was always busy, whether it was working in the yard, sewing or traveling with her husband, family or friends. She was a very caring individual who enjoyed doing things for others.

Funeral services will be at 10:00am Thursday, February 27th at Harris Funeral Home Chapel in Morrilton with Bro. Sonny Harvison officiating. Pallbearers will be Fay's sons-in-law and grandsons. Burial will follow at Oak Grove Cemetery. Visitation will be from 6 – 8 Wednesday evening at the funeral home.
