



Flo Akers Blocker Riggs

December 13, 1915 - March 20, 2011

Flo Akers Blocker Riggs, age 95, of Morrilton, Arkansas, passed away Sunday, March 20, 2011. She was born December 13, 1915, in Georgetown, Arkansas, a daughter of George W. Akers and Mary Lucinda Little Akers. Flo spent her days growing up in Georgetown, Arkansas, and graduated from high school in Kensett in 1934. After graduation from high school, she went to work at the Wakenight Hospital in Searcy, Arkansas, where she also attended nursing classes.

In 1944, when she moved to Morrilton, she started her professional career as an L.P.N. at St. Anthony's Hospital. Flo Riggs spent her entire life working and caring for others as an L.P.N. at the hospital in Morrilton until she retired in 1976. Survivors include a son David Blocker and wife Lavern of Morrilton; daughter, Mary Jane Riggs of Georgia; one granddaughter, Kimberly Ann Blocker Nelson; two great-grandsons, John David and Jake Bryan Nelson. Funeral services will be 10:00 a.m. Tuesday at the Harris Chapel with Dr. Bill Brown officiating. Burial will be at Riggs Cemetery by Harris Funeral Home of Morrilton. The family will receive friends from 6:00 to 7:00 p.m. at the funeral home.
