Floyd Fillmore Neeley, Jr., 79, of Morrilton, died Saturday, January 26, 2008. Born May 30, 1928 in Camden, he was the son of the late Floyd and Florence (Epperson) Neeley.

He was a 1946 graduate of Camden High School, and a 1951 graduate of the University of Arkansas at Fayetteville, where he received his bachelor's degree in civil engineering and was a member of Sigma Alpha Epsilon fraternity. In 1953 he became a licensed professional engineer.

Mr. Neeley was an active member of First Presbyterian Church of Morrilton, where he served in many capacities.

He is survived by sons, Floyd Fillmore Neeley III and wife Melinda, and Steven Clay Neeley all of Morrilton; one brother, Jimmy Joe Neeley and wife, Margaret of Camden; four grandchildren; two step-grandchildren and two great-grandchildren.
