Fred Hill, age 75, of Morrilton, Arkansas passed away on Thursday, November 30th in Little Rock, Arkansas. He was born on January 30, 1948, in North Little Rock, Arkansas. Fred was the son of the late Fred Sr. and Anna Sue Hill. He was a proud North Little Rock Charging Wildcat Alumnus. After high school, Fred briefly enrolled at the University of Arkansas before joining the Marines and serving our country during the Vietnam War, becoming a Sergeant, serving three tours, and being awarded two Purple Hearts.

After returning from Vietnam, he enrolled in ASTC, now UCA, and completed his bachelor's in business. He was a proud member of the Phi Lambda Chi fraternity. He went on to have a lengthy and distinguished career in sales over the next forty years working for corporations such as Lou Hoffman's, Xerox, Cordell Fishing Lures and Rods, Kyocera, and retiring from Business World in Little Rock. Fred was ahead of his time when it came to bass fishing and had a great love of being on the lake and hooking another big one; often times having some say he had forgotten more about bass fishing than some will ever know. His passion later in life was his grandkids; there wasn't an event they were participating in he wasn't supporting them when he was able.

Fred was a member of the Morrilton City Council, a proud Marine, and a Vietnam Veteran.

Fred is survived by his wife, Suzanne Hill; children Natalie (Josh) Williams, Cody (Ashleigh Williams) Hill, and Rachel (David) Williams; his grandchildren Mason, Caylee, Cord, and Case Williams all of Morrilton; and his niece and

nephew Dodie Murchison and Marty Cicardo of Texas. He was preceded in death by his parents, his sister Martha Ann Evans, and his first wife, Beverly Bland Hill.

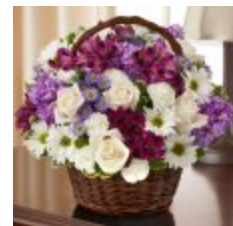

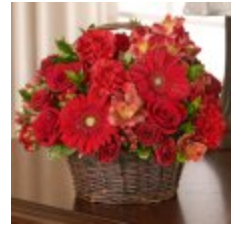
