



## Glen Franklin "Frank" Massingill

January 13, 1938 - March 1, 2019

Glen Franklin "Frank" Massingill, age 81, of Morrilton, died on March 1, 2019. Frank was born to Glen Arthur and Ola Williams Massingill on January 13, 1938, in Old Hickory, Arkansas. He was a 1956 graduate of Wonderview High School. He was a long-time member of Old Hickory Baptist church and served as overseer for Old Hickory Cemetery.
