Herbert Eugene Martin, age 68, of Petit Jean Mountain, Arkansas, passed away Saturday, October 8, 2022. He was born July 11, 1954, in Tuscumbia, Missouri, son of the late Herbert Martin and the late Wilma Patterson Martin. 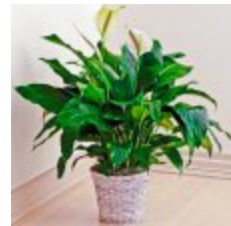
