Houston Bailey Ferguson, age 89, of Perryville, Arkansas, passed away Tuesday, May 7, 2013. He was born July 12, 1923, in Des Arc, Arkansas, a son of Sherman Ferguson and Ola Patterson Ferguson. He was a World War II Navy Veteran, having served in the South Pacific, and a member of First Baptist Church Perryville. He retired after 39 years from Southwestern Bell in Forrest City, Arkansas, and loved to hunt, fish, and tend to his garden.
