Thank God for her presence in my life. I would not have attended college without her wisdom, compassion and love..*

*She, Faye, and I had a reunion in July 2013, after not seeing each other for more than 30 years. She tried to pay for lunch but I told her absolutely not. It was an honor to pay for her. She taught us how to eat, use the right fork, talk and handle adversity.*

*I frantically tried to call Ida from February through May. Faye look in the newspaper and saw her obituary. Oh my God. I love her so much. I will see her in heaven.*
