Imelda Hoelzeman Giblin, age 91, of Morrilton, Arkansas, passed away on Saturday, December 7, 2024. She was born November 24, 1933, in Morrilton, Arkansas, the daughter of Fred Hoelzeman and Catherine Hamling Hoelzeman. After attending Sacred Heart Catholic School in Morrilton, Imelda left home at the age of 13 to join the religious life and became a School Sister of Notre Dame. For the next 25 years, she taught in numerous Catholic Schools in the South. After leaving the convent she taught for 20 years in New Orleans. She returned to Morrilton to end her teaching career at Sacred Heart Catholic School.

Other than her parents, Imelda was preceded in death by her first husband, August Giblin, Jr., and second husband, Andrew Worm; and four siblings. She is survived by ten step-children, numerous nieces and nephews, and two sisters-in-law.
