James Otha Green was born on January 18, 1914 in Casa, Arkansas and passed away on December 28, 2014 in Pasadena, Texas at the age of 100 years, 11 months and 10 days. He was the third of seven children born to the late S.V. and Ida Mae Hughes Green.

Otha was married to Treva Ann Hardin on March 21, 1937 in Morrilton, Arkansas where their two children were born. Otha and his family moved to Houston, Texas in 1943 where he worked as a brick layer. He retired from the bricklayers union in 1979 but continued to work into his 90's building brick mailboxes, fireplaces, flowerbeds and sidewalks. Otha served as a Deacon of the Broadway Church of Christ and the Southeast Church of Christ for over 50 years.
