Jay Bee Haley, age 94, of Morrilton, Arkansas, passed away Wednesday, December 6, 2017. He was born July 29, 1923, in Benton, Arkansas, a son of John Bunyan Haley and Lillie Florence Chambers Haley. He served in the Air Force in WWII then moved back to Morrilton from Sheridan in 1950 and retired after 52 yrs. of being a self - employed barber in downtown Morrilton. He was the widower of Beulah Pruitt Haley and a member of Bald Knob Missionary Baptist Church.

Survivors include his sons, Milton Haley of Morrilton and Ricky Haley and wife Nettie of Siloam Springs; five grandchildren; twenty great-grandchildren; two great-great-grandchildren; and sisters, Dulcie Cutril of Michigan and Eloise Lewis of Virginia. Other than his parents and wife, he was preceded in death by eight siblings.
