



## Jean Lamay Podvia Moore

Jean Lamay Podvia McLean Moore, formerly of Morrilton, was born in Akron, Ohio, on November 29, 1917. Her parents were Mary and Tom Podvia. Four years later her sister Helen was born. Tom worked for Firestone, and about 1938 he transferred to the Memphis, plant taking the family with him. Jean met Leo Jeffery McLean (known to everyone as Mac) at Firestone, and they were married in 1940. Children came along: Jeff in 1944, George in 1946, Fred in 1953, and David in 1957. In 1950 the family moved to Morrilton, and opened a store across from the high school. Later Jean went to work as a secretary for the school superintendent. Mac died in 1963.

In 1968, Jean married Joe Moore of Morrilton. His wife had died and he had two boys, Joe T. and Gary. Joe T. had a wife Sue and two very young kids, Marcy and Dwight. The Moore's lived in Morrilton and then on Lake Overcup until 1984, when they moved to Little Rock. Joe died in 1986. Jean Moore moved to Hot Springs; Oak Ridge, Tennessee; Chattanooga, Tennessee, and finally to Bradenton, Florida in 1992. She died December 11, 2006. Her sister Helen still lives in Bradenton, Florida; Gary Moore died four years ago and Jean's other children are all married: Joe T. and Sue in Georgetown, Texas; Jeff and Jeanne McLean in St. Paul, Minnesota; George and Lynn McLean in Tucson, Arizona; Fred and Cheryl McLean in Clearwater, Florida; David and Jill McLean in Asheville, North Carolina; Grandchildren are Marcy (Jess) Johnson of Houston, Texas; Dwight (Jennifer) Moore of Austin, Texas; Tom

and Ben McLean of Asheville, Texas; There are great-grandchildren in Texas.

Jean's ashes will be buried at Elmwood Cemetery in Morrilton, on Saturday, February 24, 2007; along side her first husband Mac and her parents. Joe Moore, his first wife, Kay and son, Gary are buried not far away. Local arrangements are by Harris Funeral Home of Morrilton.
