Jeffrey Duane Nixon, 60, of Morrilton, passed away Monday, Oct. 7, 2019, in Little Rock. He was preceded in death by his parents, Larry and Margaret (Wolfe) Nixon. Jeff was born October 4, 1959, in Lynwood, Calif., and was a member of the Downtown Church of Christ.
