



Jimmie Martin Fletcher

Our cherished and loved Jimmie Martin Fletcher, passed away on November 9, 2023, in Cherry Hill, NJ, surrounded by family. He was 90.

Jim was born in Jefferson County, Texas, to Archie Ellis Fletcher and Margarett Estell Martin Fletcher on December 23, 1932. He met his beloved wife, Emma Earle Jones, on a blind date in Alexandria, Louisiana, and they married on September 9, 1963. They had two daughters, Tanyia and Karen. Jim was artistic at heart. Early in life, Jim was a professional musician and was accomplished in clarinet and woodwinds. He played in New Orleans with many well-known groups, including Al Hurt and Pete Fountain. Jim served in the Korean War and was recruited to play in the Army General's Band. He enjoyed photography and painting and, in recent years, loved to sketch cartoons for his grandsons Alexander and Max.

He spent the majority of his working career in executive roles in retail, working to remodel and open new stores. In the nineties, Jim opened a print shop to marry his gift for retail with his love of photography and art.

When Jim wasn't working, he enjoyed going on car rides that usually resulted in a purchase, playing cards with his family, and helping mother-in-law Mazie cheat on an occasion or two at Skip-bo. Jim was a WWII buff and was an early adopter of the computer. He loved tinkering and creating family slide shows as well as other creative projects.

Jim is survived and missed by his beloved daughter Karen Missler, son-in-law Adam Missler, and grandsons Alexander and Maximilian. He is preceded in

death by his wife, Emma Earle Jones Fletcher, and daughter Tanyia; his parents, Archie Ellis Fletcher and Margarette Estell Martin Fletcher; his two brothers, Lloyd Ray and Floyd Eugene Fletcher; and sister, Pansy Barrow. He is also remembered and loved by eleven nieces and nephews and sixteen great-nieces and nephews.
