Jimmie Richard Johnson Sr, 82, of Bigelow, Arkansas, son of Osco “Skip” Richard and Carmen Christina “Connie” Frey Johnson, was born in Bigelow, Arkansas, on August 26, 1940, and died Saturday, December 31, 2022. He was the proprietor of the Bigelow Barber Shop, a member of the Wye Mountain Boys bluegrass band, and an avid fox hunter and artist.
