Jimmie John (J.J.) Magie, MD, 90, of Morrilton, died in his home on May 11, 2019. He was born on March 1, 1929, in England Arkansas to Albert and Rose Magie. He was a Korean War veteran. After completing his medical degree he was a general practice physician. In 1970 he opened his practice as an Ophthalmologist in Conway and Morrilton area until his retirement in 2018. He loved his work and he loved his patients.

He was preceded in death by his parents; his wife of 52 years, Margaret Henry Magie; two sons, Jimmie John Jr. and David Hugh; one grandson, Stephen Kyle Magie Jr.; great-granddaughter, Sunni Elizabeth Roberson; four brothers Albert, Beauchamp; Cone, and Richard; and his friend of 18 years and fiancée Kathy Acton. 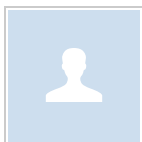
