Jimmy Wayne Holland, age 56, of Morrilton, after a long battle with cancer passed away at home surrounded by his family on Monday, January 14, 2008. He was born October 12, 1951 in Morrilton, a son of the late Gene Holland. He worked at the Morrilton, Arkansas Wal-Mart as the Meat Market Manager until September of 2002 when his illness required his resignation; prior to that he managed several meat markets in central Arkansas. Jimmy was honored with a nomination of Carver Partner of the year nationwide by Piggly Wiggly in 1987. Jimmy attended Kenwood and Kilgore Freewill Baptist Churches.
