Jimmy Earl Sutton, age 74, of Morrilton, Arkansas, passed away Tuesday, August 22, 2017. He was born February 21, 1943, in Morrilton, a son of the late George Earl Sutton and Eva Lou Millsap Sutton. He was in the United States Navy from 1961-1965. Jimmy was on the Morrilton City Council for four years prior to being Mayor of Morrilton for eight years. He was an insurance representative for Hawkins Insurance Agency and was honored by the Million Dollar Round Table for exceptional insurance sales production, as well as being awarded Top Agent in Arkansas for Allstate Finance, Inc. He was a mason, shiner, and a member of Calvary Baptist Church.
