December 6, 1943 - June 3, 2024

Judith Glennette Hogan, who resided in Morrilton, Arkansas, passed away on June 3, 2024. She was born December 6, 1943, in Morrilton, Arkansas to the late Glenn Andrew Long and Syble Olga (Isely) Long. She was 80 years old. Glennette was a retired mathematics instructor at UACCM where she taught for 20 years. She also taught at Rogers, North Little Rock, Little Rock, and at DODDS High School in Heidelberg, Germany. She was a graduate of Morrilton High School and earned both a Bachelor of Arts and a Master of Education in Mathematics from Arkansas Tech University in Russellville. Like her husband John, Glennette was awarded the Who's Who Among America's Teachers in 2004. She was a member of the Pathfinder Club, the Well-Seasoned Book Club, and the Conway Book Club, and was a faithful member of First Presbyterian Church in Morrilton where she was an Elder and sang in the choir.

Glennette is survived by three sons: Paul Hogan and wife Tiffany of Morrilton, Scott Hogan and husband Joshua, and Brad Hogan and wife Jennifer, all of Little Rock. She is also survived by two brothers: Charles Long and wife Jean of Blytheville and Sam Long and wife Brenda of Jonesboro. She leaves behind fifteen grandchildren: Luke Hogan and wife Katie of Rogers and Grant Hogan of Conway; Dylan and John Wyatt Hogan of Little Rock; Vaughn, Emma, Clark, Caroline, and Greta Hogan of Conway; Kasia and Landon Walker and PJ Hogan of Morrilton; Autumn, Trevor and Gabriel Campbell-Hogan of Little Rock; one great-granddaughter: Syble Hogan of Rogers;
