Lucian Bizzell, age 88, of Lanty, Arkansas went suddenly and peacefully to his heavenly home on August 26, 2011. He was born at Lanty, Arkansas on October 8, 1922 to Charlie and Ellen Bizzell. Lucian had the Bizzell and Earl Refrigeration Service in Little Rock for 40 years, to which he was dedicated to

his customers. He retired back to his home, Lanty, AR, where he spent the last 16 years of his life. He was a Deacon at Markham Street Baptist Church and taught the youth, adults and RA's. He has left a legacy of compassion and integrity. He was a devoted husband, father, grandfather, and great-grandfather. He served in the Coast Guard during War World II. He was also a Ham Radio Operator with the call sign KC5JMG. He loved life and liked to laugh, often!

He was preceded in death by his wife, Erma Faye of 60 years as well as his parents, sister, and brother. His survivors include his daughter Sharon McInturff (Jack), son Charles Bizzell, and daughter Donna Wright (Randy).
