Mae Katheryn Long Moore, of Morrilton, Arkansas, passed away on Friday, April 12, 2024. She was born August 11, 1934, in Morrilton to Glenn Long and Syble (Isely) Long. She was 89.

Katheryn was a retired surgical nurse who worked 50 years at the Veterans Administration Hospital in Little Rock, Arkansas, and in New Orleans, Louisiana. She was a member of the Air National Guard and served as nursing administrator for 20 years, retiring as a Lieutenant Colonel in 1994. She was a graduate of Morrilton High School and earned a Bachelor of Science Degree from Loyola University in New Orleans.

Kathryn is survived by two brothers, Charles Long and wife Jean of Blytheville, Arkansas, and Sam Long and wife Brenda of Jonesboro; and sister, Glennette Hogan of Morrilton. She also has two sons, Jeff and BJ Moore; and one grandson, Brice Moore, all of Slidell, Louisiana. In addition, she leaves behind numerous nieces and nephews who mourn her loss. She will especially be missed by great-nephew PJ.
