Margie Faye Crowder Williams, age 96, of Solgohachia, Arkansas, passed away Monday, August 14, 2017. She was born September 27, 1920, in Overcup, Arkansas, a daughter to the late King Victor Crowder and Minnie Hill Crowder. She was the widow of Hollis Marrow Williams, was a cook for Morrilton Schools, and of the Baptist faith.
