Marian Kathlene Bryant, age 67, of Formosa, Arkansas died Friday, April 8, 2011 at her home. She was born March 13, 1944, the daughter of the late Floyd and Agnes Williams of Birdtown. She was a retired dietary manager for Ozark Health of Clinton and had worked alongside her husband as a dairy

farmer and convenience store owner. Having previously battled cancer, she was glad to be called a "Survivor" and was named the 2006 Conway County Relay for Life Honorary Chair. She was a faithful member of the Formosa Church of Christ.

Survivors include her husband of almost fifty years, Roy Dee Bryant. Three sons and daughters-in-law: Harold and Tina Bryant and Brian and Amber Bryant of the Austin Community, and Dr. Bruce and Lisa Bryant of Morrilton. She is also survived by four grandsons: Zach, Haydn, Greyson, and Mills Bryant, and three great-granddaughters: Cindy (Mark) Gottsponer, Angie (Shane) Moore, and Georgia Bryant, and four great-granddaughters: Candace and Chloe Gottsponer and Daelyn and Braci Moore.
