Mark Lashley, 51, of Conway, Arkansas passed away at his home October 10, 2012. Mark was born April 18, 1961 in Farmington, Missouri. He is survived by his wife of 27 years, Patty Wright Lashley, son Alexander Chase Lashley, mother Mavis Lashley Means, brother Michael and wife Linda Lashley, sister Tammy Browers and husband Mark, and nephew Casey Browers.

Mark was a graduate of Southwest Baptist University at Bolivar, Missouri; University of Central Missouri at Warrensburg, Missouri; and Mid-America Seminary, Cordoba, Tennessee. Mark pastored Southern Baptist Churches in Arkansas for 18 years. For the last 3 years he was regional representative for Selected Funeral and Life Insurance Company.

Mark was known for his irrevocable sense of family, and his unyielding love for people. Wherever he went he maintained the spirit of community.
