Marvin Wayne Honeycutt, age 79, of Scotland, Arkansas, passed from this life into eternity on Monday, February 9, 2026. He was born January 1, 1947, in Morrilton, Arkansas, to John Marvin Honeycutt and Martha Janelle Willis.

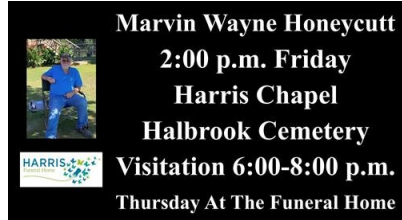
