Mary Jo French, age 49, of Oppelo, passed away Saturday, June 4, 2011. She was born August 8, 1961 in Morrilton, Arkansas. She was a counselor at Morrilton Intermediate School and attended Morrilton First Assembly of God. Mary Jo received her Bachelor's degree in 1984 and her Master's Degree in

1990 from UCA. She was a breast cancer survivor and participated in marathons, triathlons, and bike races. She was a wonderful and loving daughter, granddaughter, sister, aunt, and friend to everyone who knew her. Her sweet face and beautiful smile will be missed.
