Mary Nelle Thompson, 92, of Hope, formerly of Morrilton, died at Heather Manor Nursing Home on May 4, 2015.

She was born to Calvin Adam and Laura Brown Black on September 18, 1922, in Aplin, Arkansas. She was a member of Calvary Baptist Church of Hope and a former member of First Baptist Church, Morrilton, where she was the church secretary for many years, loving and caring for many pastors, youth directors and church members. She was very active in the W.M.U., led the Mission Friends group there and taught Sunday School as well. Along with her husband and some other church members, she helped start the First Baptist Church of Center Ridge, Arkansas.
