Nettie Lee Adams Flowers of the Sunnyside Community, Center Ridge, Arkansas, passed away on Saturday, June 29, 2019, at the age of 96. She was the oldest of seven children born to the late Sherman and Pearl Bennett Adams in the Lords School House Community, near Morrilton, on June 28, 1923.

She married James Hulon Flowers in 1945. They worked together on their farm, while raising three sons. They were married for only twenty-eight years when Hulon passed away in March 1973. Although her grandchildren never knew Hulon, she filled them with many wonderful memories of him and spoke of the hard-working, virtuous and respected man that he was.

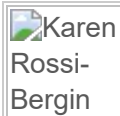

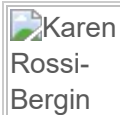
