



## Patrick Lee Nutt

May 20, 1936 - July 4, 2025

Patrick Lee Nutt, age 89, of Bigelow, Arkansas, passed away on Friday, July 4, 2025. He was born May 20, 1936, in Bigelow, Arkansas, the son of Joe Nutt, Jr. and Mildred Ellen Shelton Nutt. He was an Army veteran and a farmer. Lee was a member of the Knights of Columbus at St. Boniface Church, Perry County Cattlemen's Association, Soil Conservation Board, Farm Bureau, he was a Charter Member of the Bigelow Volunteer Fire Department, a past member of the Perry County Quorum Court, the Secretary/Treasurer of Farmers Mutual Aid Association, and was also a eucharistic minister.

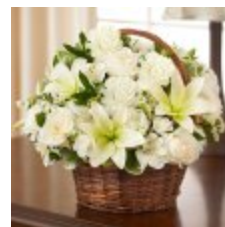
