Paul Gregory (Greg) Epperson, age 60, went to be with his Lord and Savior on Thursday, June 27, 2024. He was born June 9, 1964, in Morrilton at St. Anthony's Hospital to Paul and Brenda Rainwater Epperson. He graduated from Russellville High School in 1982, then Arkansas Tech University in 1987. He played football for Tech as a placekicker for Coach Stillman. He was in ROTC at Tech also and received his training at Fort Leonardwood, Missouri. Greg was an ordained minister and performed the marriage ceremony for his mom and step-dad. He was a retired insurance representative from American General. In his retirement he took up woodwork, which he truly loved, and made beautiful swings, chairs, trellises, flower boxes and anything that he saw that challenged him to make. He was preceded in death by his father, Paul E. Epperson; grandparents, Jesse and Flossie Epperson and Odis and Carmon Rainwater.
