Raymond Kenneth Hanson, age 93, of Morrilton, Arkansas, passed away Tuesday, February 12, 2019. He was born June 23, 1925 in Cornell, Wisconsin, a son of Carl Hanson and Harriet Vandenheuvel Hanson. He was a Navy WWII Veteran and a member of St. Matthew Lutheran Church in Conway. Raymond retired in 1987 as the Engineering Superintendent for Arkansas Kraft Corporation after 35 years. He was a former President of the Rotary Club of Morrilton, Morrilton Wastewater Utility Board Member for 10 years, former Deacon, Trustee, President, and Treasurer of Peace Lutheran in Conway, and a Board Member of Morrilton Country and Golf Club.
