“ Mom was a strong role model. She showed us a woman could do more than cook and clean. She could do almost anything outside that needed to be done. The one time I saw her frustrated was when she could not get the tiller started.

She was also a good teacher. She always had reading materials in our home, and that was a financial sacrifice. We had encyclopedias, Bible story books, the magazine Highlights, and it was Christmas when we could order a book from school.

We learned how to alphabetize by putting all the bills from the shop in ABC order on the kitchen table.

I remember having a hard time learning my 4 multiplication facts. I would sit on the counter while she was cooking and she would drill me. Like the tiller that would not start, she got frustrated. Until finally she said, “What is 4x6?” I didn’t know so she said, “what is 6 6”? I said 12. She then said, “What is 12 12”? Until the day I retired from teaching, I used this strategy for students that struggled with their 4 facts.

The Mysteries of the Rosary were also hard for me. She told me to think about the story each Mystery tells. To this day I can hear her say that every time I say the rosary.

Cherish every second with your family.

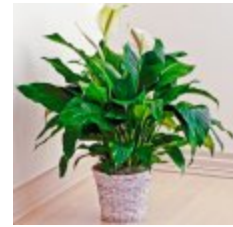

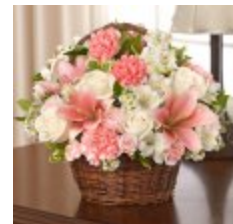
