



## Richard Dwayne "Tuffy" Miller

April 22, 1939 - October 16, 2025

Dwayne "Tuffy" Miller, 86, of Plumerville, Arkansas, passed away peacefully on October 16, 2025, surrounded by family and friends. Born on April 22, 1939, Dwayne grew up in Plumerville and graduated from Plumerville High School. He was a member of the Portland Missionary Baptist Church in Plumerville.

As a boy, Dwayne spent much of his time outdoors; swimming in the creeks and at Cadron, fishing, hunting squirrels and rabbits, and playing basketball for his school. Those early days in Plumerville shaped his lifelong love of sports and being active.

After high school, Dwayne proudly served in the military and went on to work for many years at Virco, where he later retired. Never one to stay idle, he continued working for Jim Smith Wrecker Service, where his dependability and work ethic earned him the respect of everyone who knew him.

Dwayne's love of sports carried into adulthood. He spent countless hours refereeing and umpiring softball games throughout the community. Whether he was behind the plate, on the court, or in the stands, he brought enthusiasm, humor, and a friendly spirit to every game. A devoted Razorback fan, he could always be heard calling the Hogs, especially during basketball season.

He never missed a family game or gathering and was known for being social, easygoing, and always ready to visit or share a laugh.

Dwayne was preceded in death by his parents, Orville G. and Lodis Self

Miller; his wife, Nadean Miller; daughter-in-law, Sherry Miller; three brothers, Donnie, Larry, and Ronnie Miller; and a sister, Diana Smith.
