Samuel Salvadore Lasuzzo III, age 87, of Monroe, Louisiana, formerly of Morrilton, Arkansas, passed away on September 17, 2025, in Monroe, Louisiana. Mr. Lasuzzo was born on June 29, 1938, in Monroe.

His grandfather was the first-generation immigrant from Cefalu Sicily Italy.
